Some of the issues were; Liquid faction, Structural buildings, Natural gas lines, Commodities, Dept. Of Transportation.

CUBE VAN: Randall Ganues (UMCOR) informed us of their new self sustained vehicle(s) consisting of a generator, H2O, stove. This would be supported by a 2 man HAM team and would have provisions for a 10 man team. There would be one stationed in each conference in their work to minister ~~and nurse~~ to those in need.

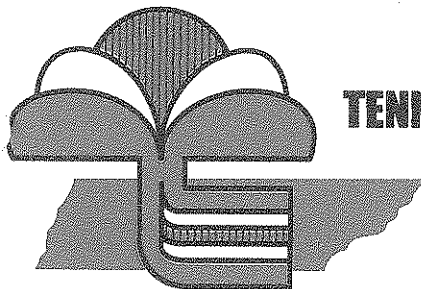

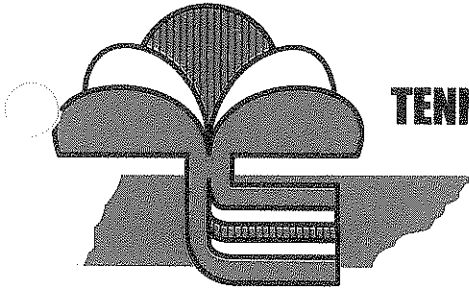
