Secretary's report: on Website

Treasurer's report: Began the year with \$10,827 in January \$5,000 heaters for Humphreys County. National VOAD expenses leaving a current balance of \$3,183.27. The \$5,000 was a subgrant to TN VOAD for heaters through a member from National VOAD.

Additions and deletions from the agenda

Presentation of the Program: Pat Lawson-Community Foundation Middle TN:

Pat Lawson shared history and mission of CFMT. (31 years of helping nonprofits with financial efforts-Disaster focus began in 2010 in response to the major flood.) More than One Billion dollars distributed in the 31-year history.

Funding is still being distributed to response and recovery partners from all the disasters impacting Middle Tennessee.

CFMT helps raise money and distribute funds for designated partners or purposes. CFMT vets the organizations to ensure the funding will be used in the best way according to donor intent. CFMT can partner with TN VOAD to help raise and distribute funding in all phases of disasters. CFMT does not charge any fees for the disaster related funding raised and distributed.

David Sledge recommended that CFMT become a full voting member of TN VOAD.

CFMT is a nonprofit organization serving all Middle Tennessee, which meets the requirements for full membership. David Sledge also recommended that CFMT should serve with Gary Ward on the Finance Committee.

CFMT can become the fundraising "staff" for TNVOAD.

Pat Lawson will provide the guidelines for grant requests and reporting through David Sledge. Pat Lawson has a portal for grant requests and a committee of CFMT and TN VOAD determines needs and processes grants to nonprofits. CFMT is able to facilitate funding for all 95 counties in the State.

## Committee reports:

Communications Committee, Chair David Sledge:

Communications: Research a communications database for TN VOAD to communicate and alert partners that fit the need. David suggested EverBridge or another similar database.

## TN VOAD Workshop Committee-Chair Kate Amaral:

Quarterly workshops throughout the State focused on preparedness. First hosted March 18, 2023, in Williamson County at the EMA office in Franklin. The first is focused on Sheltering with the partnership of the Red Cross. The other three will include Long Term Recovery Group Formation, Donations Management, and Volunteer Management.

- \*Hamilton and Putnam Counties have offered to host additional workshops.
- \*Quarter 3 Volunteer Management, Q3-Donations Management, Q4-LTRG Formation Spiritual and Emotional Care is an important in all components of response and recovery. The initial four topics were chosen due to the responses of local EMA Directors. S\$E Care is a specific topic scheduled for 2024.

Civil air patrol: transported medical equipment from Knoxville to Puerto Rico. Training taking place on drones and communications in emergencies. HAM radio operators to become a part of the state VOAD.

Lutheran Disaster Services: Active in TN, MS, FL, with recovery funding, volunteers, and S&E care.

St. Vincent DePaul: 100 home furnishings available for the state of TN. Connected with LTRGs and TEMA.

National Response Canines: Responded to the school shooting in Uvalde, TX and provided feedback to Williamson County Schools for future preparation and response to similar events. Also, awaiting deployment to St. Louis and Florida.

Team Rubicon: 300 volunteers in Florida and supporting operations in Ukraine. Exploring Alabama and Mississippi needs from recent tornadoes. Working with partners from Isra-Aid.

## Regional VOADS:

Metro VOAD-closed out the flood recover from March 2021 event, 6 open cases March 2020 tornado, bombing focused on emotional care, 2021 tornado-19 remaining cases. Two new members as membership renewal is happening. Finalizing rewrite of Points of Consensus.

East Tennessee VOAD: Evan Rogers (TEMA-Knoxville) liaison to East Regional VOAD from TEMA and the regional VOAD tasked him to reestablish the East Regional VOAD. Knoxville EMA is assisting in reinstituting the East Tennessee VOAD, meetings take place at the EMA office. David shared some basic info on establishing an officially recognized regional VOAD.

Williamson County: will hold elections Wednesday, November 9,2022.
